

TIPS FOR STARTING AT SCC

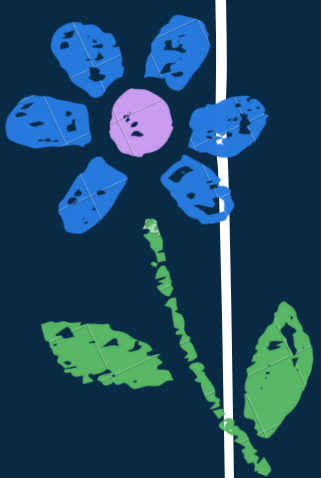
#1

Talk to your child about what is happening - show them the daily schedule (next page)



#2

Drop off time - sign in your child, and find an educator to give you a tour and discuss with your child what their favourite activities are! (list of toys on next page)



#3

Try to make the drop off process as quick as possible to minimise any separation anxiety

Bring a cuddly toy from home or ask for our centre toy if your child is upset!

#5

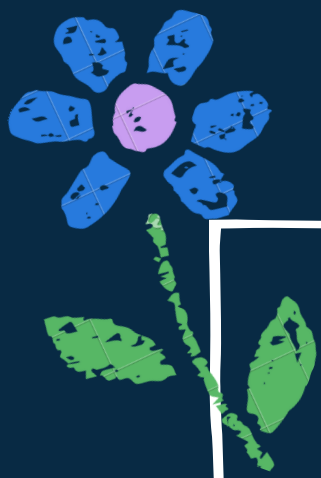
If your child is upset the best thing to do is give them a quick kiss and cuddle and then leave them with an educator

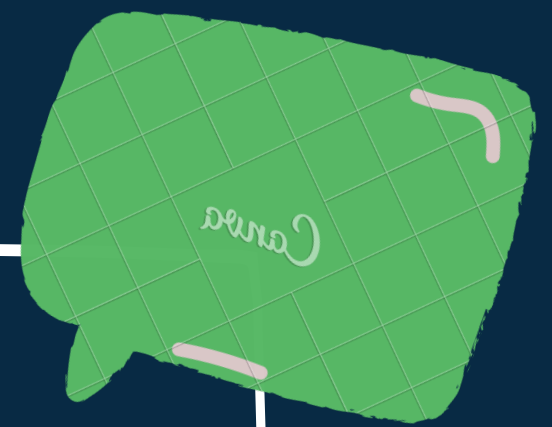
