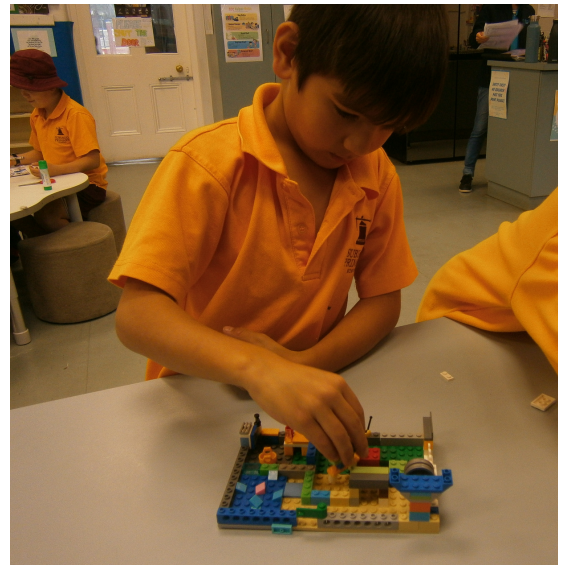

Term 3 before & after school care summary

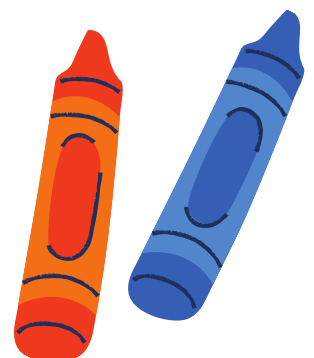
We had a very busy and fun school term.

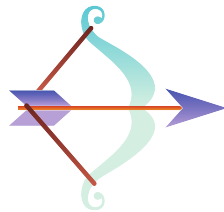
